AN ACTIVITY IN FIVE PHASES.

1

Presentation of the Lithuanian video *Experiment - Translation*. What do I do when I encounter hate speech online?

2

Students are asked to define the meaning of the emoticons and then to use them to categorise the comments.

3

Students are given a selection of the 100,000 comments published online and they are asked to divide them according to the criteria represented and defined by the emoticons.

4

Thinking about language: qualitative considerations: which words are used most frequently?

5

Choose a comment as a group and analyse it in depth; how could the comment be rewritten to avoiding inciting hatred?
